Nov 9: Evagrius the Solitary, On Discrimination

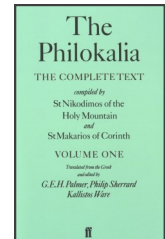
Dec 7: Evagrius the Solitary, On Prayer
