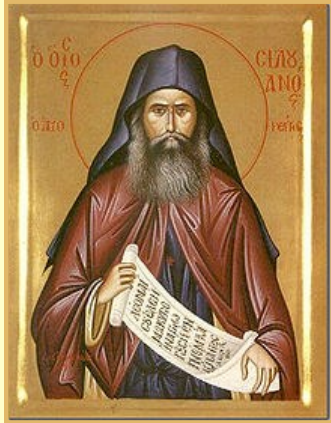


St. Philip's Annual Lenten Retreat
